

**How to Meet CLANH Continuing Education Requirement
for Practitioner Members
of 6 hours every 2 years (even years), 5/1 to 4/30**

Requirements for biennium and must be completed in biennium or practitioner status lost and name removed from CLANH website. Up to 3 hours may be carried over to next reporting biennium. Requirements may be met by training action as listed below. Notice of completion of training action must be certified by member on member's letterhead to CLANH, P.O. Box 2161, Concord NH 03302.

1. Intermediate Collaborative Practice Training, live and as offered by CLANH.
2. Collaborative Training offered by other entity as approved in advance by inquiry to CLANH.
Massachusetts Collaborative Law Council group offers training several times a year.

3. Mediation Skills Training
This can be a complete basic mediation training (30-48 hours) or a continuing education program on mediation skills.
4. Reading an approved text/using approved instructional materials. Each must be followed, within 30 days with collegiate conference (see below) or phone continuing education program. For list of Approved texts go to <http://www.collaborativelawnh.org/infoforattorneys.htm>, then to "Click here for Approved Instructional Materials"
- 5 Collegiate conference of 1 hour or more. This is a meeting with 2 or more other Collaborative professionals to discuss collaborative practice (phone or in person).
Examples: discussion of portion of approved text (see D), case conference with more experienced practitioner(s) about a "problem case."
6. Telephone continuing education by CLANH.
